## You're Invited!

The Ipswich River just became more accessible. Please join the Town of Ipswich and the Ipswich River Watershed Association (IRWA) at 11 am on Thursday, August 19th for the dedication of the new Peatfield Street Landing dock at 21 Peatfield Street, Ipswich. The Peatfield Street Landing is the first public launch above the Ipswich Mills dam, and the closest to IRWA's Riverbend headquarters, located 1 mile upstream. Improvements to the landing have been ongoing for some years, including improved signage and an informational kiosk. The proximity to the dam and low usage has made this one of the more difficult landings to put in or take out. The new dock seeks to improve access to this under-utilized landing, which is within walking distance of downtown attractions and restaurants, and can be reached easily from the train station.

To commemorate all the effort expended by many to make these landing improvements happen, Town Manager Tony Marino, Harbormaster Paul Nikas, and IRWA's Executive Director Wayne Castonguay will share a few words at the dedication ceremony. After the dedication, there will be an inaugural paddle. You're welcome to bring your own kayak, canoe or paddle board and join in!
