From the Yard

- ✓ Poisons, Insecticides, Fungicides
- ✓ Chemical Fertilizers, Weed Killers
- ✓ Mothballs
- ✓ Flea Control Products

From the House

- ✓ Nail Polish, Hair Color
- ✓ Rubber Cement, Airplane Glue
- ✓ Fiberglass Resins
- ✓ Photo Chemicals
- ✓ Chemistry Sets
- ✓ Furniture Polish
- ✓ Floor & Metal Polish
- ✓ Oven Cleaner
- ✓ Drain & Toilet Cleaner
- ✓ Spot Cleaner & Spot Remover
- ✓ Rug & Upholstery Cleaner
- ✓ Hobby Supplies, Artist Supplies
- ✓ Oil-Based & Epoxy Paint, Stains, Varnishes, Strippers, Thinners & Polyurethane

How to Transport These Items Safely

Leave materials in original containers. Tighten caps & lids. Sort & pack separately: paint solvents, pesticides, household cleaners, etc. **NEVER MIX CHEMICALS!** **NEVER SMOKE** while handling hazardous materials!

Do NOT Bring!!

- ⊗ Ammunition, Fireworks, & Explosives
- ⊗ Cathode Ray Tubes, Electronics
- ⊗ Commercial & Industrial Waste
- ⊗ Empty Containers/Trash
- ⊗ Fire Extinguishers/Smoke Detectors
- ⊗ Infectious & Biological Wastes
- ⊗ **Latex Paint – It is not hazardous**
- ⊗ Non-hazardous materials
- ⊗ Organic Peroxides, Metal Powders
- ⊗ Partially Empty Propane Tanks
- ⊗ Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs)
- ⊗ Prescription Medicines/Syringes
- ⊗ Radioactive Waste

* Fuels, up to 21 gallons maximum, **cannot be transported in the passenger section of the vehicle and must be transported in the trunk.**

** Residents may also bring **up to 4 personal-vehicle tires**
